12-02-02 INCORPORATION

Section 12-02-01 AIRPORT DISTRICT

This Ordinance is the legal implementation of a continuing comprehensive planning process for the development of the Boise Air Terminal (Gowen Field) District, which had heretofore been known and designated as the Boise Air Terminal Airport District. The said Boise Air Terminal Airport District was jointly and severally drafted and approved by the legislative bodies of Ada County and Boise City respectively as part of, and implementing, the Boise Air Terminal Airport Ordinance on May 10, 1960, and May 31, 1960, and is hereby redesignated and shall hereafter be known as the Boise Air Terminal (Gowen Field) District. The map or maps of said Boise Air Terminal Airport District respectively approved on May 10, 1960 and May 31, 1960, together with all notations, references and other information shown thereon, and as amended by this Ordinance, are incorporated herein and made a part hereof as if fully set forth and described herein. It is the intention of the legislative bodies of Ada County and Boise City that each will jointly and separately enact and enforce zoning regulations necessary to implement and place in effect the comprehensive plan for said Airport District.

Section 12-02-02 INCORPORATION

There are incorporated herein by reference the definitions of "Subdivider" and "Subdivision" of the Boise City and Ada County Subdivision Ordinances as said definitions apply to the respective jurisdictions now enforced and as hereinafter amended. Any application made under said Boise City/Ada County Subdivision Ordinances for subdivision of land or dedication of any public street or easement shall be subject to the terms of this Ordinance and shall require the issuance of a permit as set forth in Section 8.0/12-8-0 hereof if it falls within a zone where such permits are required. If such application under the Boise City/Ada County Subdivision Ordinances is for approval of a plat, the issuance of such permit and the conditions thereof shall be endorsed on the face of the plat.
