Section 2-01-01 BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS

It is hereby determined by the Boise City Council that a single, cohesive and consistent policy is required to order the relationship of all Boise City boards and commissions pursuant to the Boise City Code and Idaho State law.

Section 2-01-02 DUTIES OF BOISE CITY BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS

Unless specific activities or duties are enumerated elsewhere in this Ordinance, all Boise City Boards and Commissions shall operate in an advisory capacity only to the Mayor of Boise City and the Boise City Council. Any activities, duties or responsibilities delegated by permanent boards and commissions shall be by ordinance and not otherwise.

Section 2-01-03 COMPENSATION TO BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS

Unless otherwise provided in this ordinance, all members of any Boise City Boards and Commissions shall serve without compensation. However, actual and necessary expenses may be allowed with the prior approval of the Mayor and Boise City Council.

Section 2-01-04 REPORTS TO COUNCIL

Unless otherwise provided in this Ordinance, each Boise City Board or Commission shall provide its own manner of organizing its manner of doing business including but not limited to the regularity of its meetings.

Each Boise City Board or Commission shall provide minutes of its meetings to the Boise City Council after each regular or special meeting of such board or commission. Each Boise City Board or Commission shall maintain such records as are required by law, provided for in the internal organization of the board or commission or as the Mayor or City Council may from time to time require or request.

Section 2-01-05 APPOINTMENTS

Unless otherwise provided, all appointments to boards or commissions which shall be permanent boards or commissions shall be made by the Mayor of Boise City with the consent of the Boise City Council. All members of boards or commissions may be removed from service on such boards and

committees in a like manner as is provided for their appointment.

Section 2-01-06 RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT

Unless otherwise provided by this Code, members of every Boise City Board or Commission must be, at the time of their appointment and throughout the tenure of their membership, residents of Boise City, however, it is provided herein that one member of a board and commission may be a resident of Ada County who resides within the Boise City/Ada County Area of Impact, as that document may, from time to time, be amended, except as provided for by Section 2-05-01 and 2-06-03, Boise City Code. Section 2-01-07 RESIGNATIONS OR VACATIONS

Should any member of any Boise City Board or Commission resign or should a vacancy on any Boise City Board or Commission become available, a replacement board or commission member shall be appointed in a manner consistent with this Chapter to fill out the term of office for that originally provided for the member resigning or vacating office on such board or commission.
