Section 3-01-01 CHIEF OF POLICE

The Director of the Police Department shall be the Chief of Police, who shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council. The Chief shall have such powers, functions and duties as may be prescribed by this Code, statutes of the State, or as may be imposed upon the Chief by the Mayor or Council. The Chief of Police will appoint and manage all employees assigned to and employed by the Department.

Section 3-01-02 POLICE DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEES

The Police Department shall consist of a Chief of Police and any other employees the Chief of Police deems necessary. Additional employees of the Department shall be added in accordance with City policies, this Code, statutes of the State and upon approval of the Mayor and Council.

Section 3-01-03 POLICE OFFICER; DUTIES

It shall be the duty of each police officer within the Police Department to enforce the provisions of this Code, other laws of the City and the statutes of the State, and to perform such duties as may be prescribed by his or her superior officers and by the Mayor and Council.

Section 3-01-04 SPECIAL POLICE

Special police may be appointed and upon appointment shall be assigned to such functions, area of operation, duties and powers of police as may be designated by the Chief of Police. Such special police shall be subject to dismissal at any time. Special police shall act without pay unless otherwise provided by the Mayor and City Council.

Section 3-01-10 LAW ENFORCEMENT HORSES OR DOGS PERMITTED

Any horse or dog utilized by the police department for a lawful duty or function shall be authorized to enter upon or remain at locations open to the public where the animal's presence is otherwise restricted, limited or prohibited.
