Section 9-09-01 PROTECTION OF STREETS

When signs are erected giving notice thereof, it shall be unlawful for any person to operate a commercial vehicle exceeding five thousand (5,000) pounds gross weight at any time upon any street, alley and way, or parts thereof, except temporarily (a) for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading goods, merchandise or persons or (b) by service and emergency vehicles. Section 9-09-02 WEIGHT, SPEED AND TIRE REGULATIONS

Chapter 9 of Title 49, Idaho Code, entitled "Weight, Speed and Tire Regulations," and all provisions of said Chapter and all amendments thereof to the date of the passage hereof, shall be applicable to and apply to the City, and are hereby adopted as the ordinances of the City, and it shall be unlawful and punishable as a misdemeanor to violate any of the provisions thereof within the Corporate Limits of the City; provided, that wherever in said Chapter the words "Idaho Board of Highway Directors" is used, there shall be substituted in lieu thereof "The Commissioner of Public Works of the City." Section 9-09-03 RESPONSIBILITY FOR DAMAGE

The owner and the operator of any vehicle or contrivance over any street or bridge within the City, shall be jointly and severally responsible for all damages which said street or bridge may sustain as the result of illegally operating such vehicle, or as the result of driving or moving any vehicle weighing in excess of the maximum weight specified in this Chapter, but authorized by a temporary permit, and the amount of such damages may be recovered in an action at law by the authorities in control of the street or bridge. Section 9-09-04 LIMITING LIABILITY OF AUTHORITIES

No action or proceeding of any nature or description shall lie against the Department of Public Works or any other City authorities charged with the administration of this Chapter because of their compliance with any of the terms of this Chapter or the exercise of any authority of the performance of any duties granted or prescribed herein. Section 9-09-05 OIL DRIPPINGS PROHIBITED

Boise Municipal Code

It shall be unlawful for any person operating any vehicle using gasoline or any product of petroleum to permit to drain off from the crank case or gear case, or from any other part of said vehicle, or to spill, waste, or empty any product of petroleum on any of the paved streets of the City. Section 9-09-06PENALTY

It shall be unlawful and constitute a misdemeanor for any person to violate any of the provisions of this Chapter. (Ord. 1571; 1963 Code, 10-1013; 1952 Code, Sec. 14-715)
