**Section 9-12-01REPLACEMENT OF WATER MAINS**

Any person maintaining a water main or pipe in the streets and alleys of the City where pavement now exists shall, when and as said water mains or pipes require replacement, replace them with ferrous and non-ferrous mains or pipes and fittings as approved by the Plumbing Fixtures and Materials Plumbing Board established by Section 4-1-20 of this Code, and thereafter maintain such mains or pipes under said pavement.

**Section 9-12-02NOTICE BY COUNCIL TO REPLACE**

Whenever the Council shall decide by appropriate action to proceed with the paving or resurfacing of any streets or alley within the City, and it shall be determined that any water mains or pipes in the streets or alleys are of material other than that prescribed by Section 9-12-1, the Council shall cause notice to be given to the person owning said water mains or pipes of its intention to pave or resurface the street or alley, and the person owning the water mains or pipes shall replace the same within thirty (30) days after receipt of said notice, and shall thereafter maintain such mains or pipes under the pavement or resurfacing laid or constructed. **Section 9-12-03PENALTY**

Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Chapter shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) and each day's failure to comply with the provisions of this Chapter after the expiration of the time herein limited shall be deemed and constitute a separate offense.
